BUSINESS MEETING


The December Business Meeting will be Wednesday, December 12, at 6:30 PM.

The youth will be hosting a waffle breakfast on Sunday, December 16, at 8:00 AM. All donations will go toward their upcoming Xtreme Winter Conference.




CHRISTMAS CANTATA
