Dear HBC Family,

Today is April 15th which is historically known as Income Tax Day in our country. Most Americans spend the first three months of each year

sorting through papers and receipts as they prepare to submit their tax return before the deadline. Yes, this is an important day of accounting in American life, but it is not the most important day. Notice the words of the Apostle Paul in the passage below to the church at Philippi.

Philippians 3" 7-11

But what things were gain to me, these I have counted loss for Christ. 8 Yet indeed I also count all things loss for the excellence of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them as rubbish, that I may gain Christ 9 and be found in Him, not having my own righteousness, which is from the law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which is from God by faith; 10 that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection, and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death, 11 if, by any means, I may attain to the resurrection from the dead.

Paul had considered all of his gains in life in the earlier part of chapter three, but he realized that all of his gains were a loss when compared to what he gained when he met Jesus Christ. He had a great reputation as a scholar and religious leader. He was proud of his Jewish heritage and religious achievements. All of these things were valuable to him, but there was no eternal profit to be gained from them. All that Paul had gained in life was nothing more than rubbish to

him when he compared his earthly possessions to the riches he had found in Jesus Christ. When Paul counted everything in his life, he was able to proclaim that nothing mattered more to him or even came close to the value of his relationship with Jesus Christ.

How about you? What are the things in this life that really matter to you? Have you placed a higher value on earthly treasures or the blessings of your relationship with Christ? Paul declares the main thrust of his life in verse 10, "That I may know Him". He had one desire and one desire alone and that was to know Jesus on the most intimate level possible. We, too, must desire to know Jesus in the same way. God bless and I pray you ALL have a wonderful week. Never forget that I love you and there's nothing you can do about it!
